

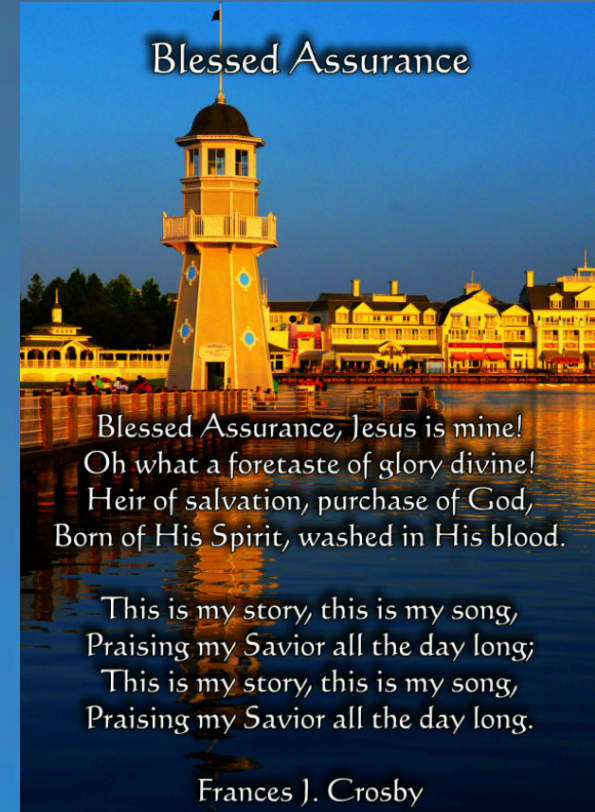

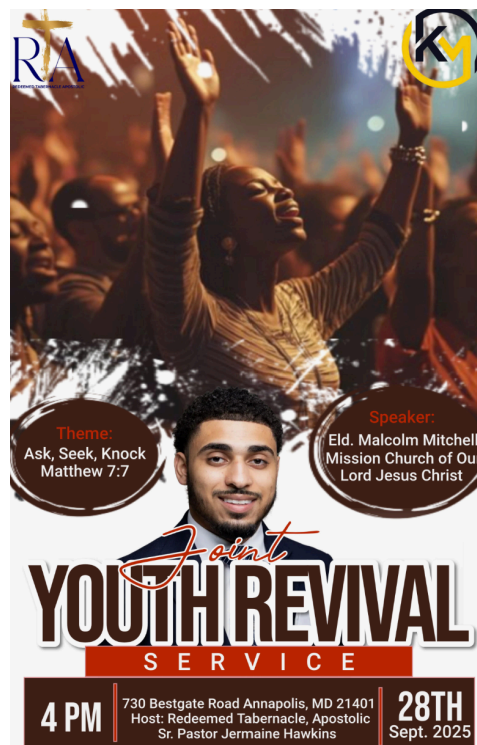
We believe that the regeneration of the Holy Ghost is essential for personal salvation.
